COVID-19 Alert level 2 and Waipukurau Little Theatre

Under Alert level 2 we are able to operate the theatre and produce shows, but in a restricted format. Things will be a little different from usual. This is how we will operate.

- All ticket sales will be for general admission. No reserved seats.
- Maximum capacity will be 30 seats in rows, no tables with all seats at least 1m away from each other.
- All patrons must either scan or sign in and use hand sanitizer on entry.
- Patrons will have to line up outside with only one bubble in the theatre foyer at a time.
- The pavement outside the theatre and the carpet inside the theatre will be marked to aid social distancing.
- Patrons are encouraged to wear masks as will staff while in the theatre unless eating or drinking.
- Tea and coffee will be served at half time and the bar will be open before the show and at half time. Patrons will need to collect their own drinks and observe social distancing while doing so.
- Prior to each performance patrons will be briefed as to procedures.
- There will be no dinner night.

Should we go to Alert level 1 prior to the show then the capacity will be increased to 60 seats, but will still be by general admission with seats in rows and no tables.

We ask all patrons to be considerate, take care of your own and others safety. If we do this, then we
