#### Synopsis: A light-hearted look at a serious topic


A breast cancer support group meets once a month in a small-town community hall.

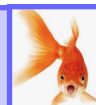
