Steven Canny's and John Nicholson's adaption of Sir Arthur Conan Doyle's 'The Hound of the Baskervilles' is anything but ordinary. A farce where NOTHING is elementary. This zany, slapstick spoof follows three members of a theatre troupe haplessly trying to put on their version of this well-known classic against all odds. Gothic thrills and uproarious mayhem ensue when Sherlock Holmes and his trusty sidekick Watson attempt to unravel the ancient curse of the Baskerville family before the Hound claims its next victim.





The show is extremely technical and very fast paced where a small cast of three actors playing 18 parts leads to some enormous challenges. A strong backstage crew of five, who make many on stage appearances, help move the action seamlessly from one scene to the next and add to the hilarity of the situation.
