Waipukurau Little Theatre's latest offering is the multi-award winning "Agnes of God" by John Pielmeier. A thought-provoking drama, loosely based on a true story, it investigates the story of Agnes, a postulant nun who is accused of murdering her baby. The play presents the contrasts of the relationships between the Mother Superior, the Court Psychiatrist and Agnes. It is a psychological war questioning spirituality and science, facts and faith, reality and fantasy.

Agnes is pulled almost vehemently between the fact finding atheist psychiatrist and the believer of miracles Mother Superior. Both women are overwhelmed with





personal agendas and "skeletons in the closet". Yet these women of power are so enchanted by the seemingly magical nature of Agnes they question themselves, their beliefs and throughout the context of the play experience personal growth.

Agnes, a simple yet complex young woman teetering on the edge of complete insanity through her apparent ignorance and innocence is blessed with an enigmatic voice that enchants those who hear her. She shows signs of complete manic hysteria yet is involved in calm conversations with God complete with stigmata. These miracles are both questioned and examined by both of her superiors who hold their own motives.

Agnes of God will both entertain and provoke and promises deep investigation into the three women's psyche.


